### RoHs Directive

Exclusion of dangerous substances – EU directive 2002/95/EG, 2003/11/EG and 2005/618/EG (RoHs)

In order to adhere to this directive, our galvanic equipment has been changed to chrome-VI-free zinc-plating.

It is to be emphasised that we will keep on supplying our steel and malleable-iron articles yellow-coloured because the formerly yellow chromising containing chrome VI has been replaced by a high-grade chrome-VI-free yellow passivation.

In the future our steel and malleable-iron products will not change their look as demanded by our customers, the RoHs directive will be adhered to and the quality of our coupling systems "Made in Germany" will be improved once more due to this high-grade surface treatment. The compliance with all other standards of the RoHs directive is also guaranteed regarding our suppliers of semi-finished goods and all internal production proceedings.
